



Wesley Wong, SC

Wesley Wong read law at the University of Hong Kong and was called to the local bar in 1993. He was Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions before appointed as the 5th Solicitor General of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. He spends his entire legal career at the Department of Justice, having been posted to different parts of it and undertaking both civil as well as criminal work before the courts or otherwise. The promotion of Hong Kong as a leading international legal and dispute resolution centre comes under the portfolio of the Department's Legal Policy Division which Mr Wong heads.

Mr Wong was a member of the High Court and Court of Final Appeal Rules Committees and currently sits on the Higher Rights Assessment Board for solicitor advocates. From time to time, he volunteers for the Hong Kong Advocacy Training Council and at local law schools. He has been an accredited mediator since 2009 and was appointed Senior Counsel by the Chief Justice in 2013.
